



## **BIG CHANGES FOR JESUS RACING TEAM in 2009**

2009 looks like being a big one for the Jesus Racing Team.

As the figurehead for the Bible Society's Jesus. All about life campaign, Jesus Racing, headed up by driver Andrew Fisher, will continue their speaking engagements off the track.

But on the track, things will be a little different.

This year, both the Jesus Ute and the Supercar will run out of the same workshop.

They will come under the umbrella of Sieders Racing, where engineer Luke Sieders will oversee the race-readiness of both vehicles.

"It is important to have both cars running out of the one workshop," Andrew says. "It means greater control and accessibility."

"We have had a strong connection with Luke and the Sieders race team for several years so believe this is the best way to go for the team as a whole."

The Jesus Ute will continue to race in all eight rounds of the Yokohama V8 Ute Series, where driver Andrew Fisher will strive for great results.

Due to the enormous expense involved in motorsport, the Jesus V8 Supercar is signed up for the three signature events on the Fujitsu Supercar calendar.

Andrew will again race at Bathurst in October. He will also drive the Supercar at the flagship events in Townsville and at Sydney's Homebush 400, which is Sydney's first ever street-race.

In addition to the new 'home base', the racing cars will bear new livery. Both cars are now stunning black, red and silver, which is guaranteed to pull focus on the track.

The team is also proud to welcome Compassion Australia as a major partner to the Jesus Racing Team.

Compassion is an international organisation that focuses on releasing children from poverty in the name of Jesus.

They work in partnership with local churches of in 25 of the world's developing nation to foster the development of children who live in poverty.

Andrew has been a supporter of Compassion for many years and is excited to have come together with the charity organization, promoting them at the hundreds of schools and events they attend each year.

"Compassion fits perfectly with the Jesus Racing Team," says Andrew. "We promote 'Jesus the person' while Compassion expresses his practical side, working to meet the needs of the poor and disadvantaged," he says.

The Jesus Racing Team is the figurehead of a massive multi-media campaign which will run across Sydney in September and October this year.

'Jesus. All about life' is a non-denominational advertising program being run by Bible Society NSW, which aims to encourage Sydneysiders to think about their faith.

It's hoped that by September, 2000 of Sydney's churches will be signed up to participate in the program.

"This is going to be an enormous year for the Jesus Racing team," says Andrew.

"We are confident of strong performances on the track, and have a multitude of events lined up off the track, to take the name of Jesus places it's never been before."
