RACE DRIVER ANDREW FISHER TO SPEAK AT THE CHAMPION MEN'S CONFERENCE.

Race car driver Andrew Fisher is quickly becoming one of Australia's highest-profile Christians, particularly within the mainstream market.

Andrew races in the Yokohama V8 Ute Series and the Fujitsu V8 Supercar series at motorsport events right across Australia, with the name of Jesus right down the side of his car.

One million people see him race live at race tracks every year. Another 30 million worldwide watch the races on television.

The 'Jesus V8 Ute' was featured at the recent Top Gear spectaculars at Sydney's ACER arena, where it was highlighted in front of an estimated audience of 70,000 people.

Off the track, Andrew has extensive public speaking commitments.

These include presentations to more than 50,000 high school students every year, where he speaks about the importance of having courage both on and off the racetrack.

This weekend, Andrew will line up alongside pre-eminent Christians Tim Costello and Brian Houston at the Champions Men's Conference in Brisbane.

The conference is being held at the Brisbane City Church in Bowen Hills.

More than a thousand men are expected to attend the event, which aims to encourage men to be Real, Strong and Connected.

Brian Houston and his wife Bobbie are the senior Pastors at Hillsong in Sydney, speaking to around 20,000 people every weekend. Brian is also the National President of Australian Christian Churches, which is a movement representing more than 1000 churches and 210,000 Christians across Australia.

The Rev Tim Costello is one of Australia's leading voices on social justice. He has been the CEO of World Vision since 2004 and has been instrumental in placing global poverty on the national agenda. Tim was named Victorian of the Year in 2004,

was given an Order of Australia in 2005 and named Victorian Australian of the Year in 2006.

Andrew will speak about the importance of doing things with intention, as well as his relationship with International Aid Organisation Compassion and his recent trip to India, where he witnessed Compassion's works first-hand.

Andrew is also the face of the 'Jesus. All about life' campaign, which is a massive multi-media project which will run throughout Sydney and the whole of NSW in September this year.

All of the Christian denominations have registered their support for the Bible Society program, which focuses on advertising to encourage people to consider the person of Jesus- or at least start asking questions.

More than 500 churches have also signed up to be part of the campaign. It's expected that by September, more than 2000 churches will be on board, to leverage off the advertising campaign within local communities.
